- 6. To Align with Global value chain.





Policy Interventions



CAPEX Support



CAPEX support

- @ 20% for Non-IT infrastructure
- @30% for IT infrastructure

- Up to INR 50 Cr for Category I units with GFCI < INR 250 Cr.
- Up to INR 200 Cr for Category II-Mega Projects with GFCI >= INR 250 Cr.

CAPEX Components

- 1. Expenditure on GFCI:
 Construction and Purchase
 of the building,
 Computers, Software,
 Networking related
 hardware and other
 related fixed assets
 (excluding the cost of land)
- 2. Stamp Duty and Registration Fees
- 3. Renewable Energy Expenditure




OPEX Support



OPEX support @ 15%.

 Bandwidth & Cloud Rental capped up to 35% of the eligible OPEX

- Up to INR 20 Cr for Category I units with GFCI < INR 250 Cr.
- Up to INR 40 Cr for Category II-Mega Projects with GFCI >= INR 250 Cr.
